Francis S. Urbain, Indianapolis, was born in 1937 to Elsie (Curtis) and Paul Urbain. Francis lived among his close-knit family his entire life, and through the 38th and Shadeland Community Improvement Association, made every effort to maintain the quality of life in his neighborhood. Francis was a lifelong member of what is now the Lawrence United Methodist Church, which was organized in the home of his ancestors.

Francis graduated from Warren Central High School, then attended Jordan Conservatory of Music of Butler University. His mother instilled in him a love of music, and Francis was employed by the Indianapolis Conservatory of Music as a clarinet and steel guitar instructor from 1951 to 1958. His favorite genre was country and western swing

His father influenced an interest in mechanics. Francis was employed by the U. S. Postal Service for 40 years, responsible for purchasing and maintaining USPS vehicles, and was awarded a commendation for his service. He collected 1970 Buicks, and attended national shows of the Buick Club of America.

Francis lived a good life, and went in peace on December 24, 2018, to join his parents and his grandparents Grace and Peter Curtis, professing his belief in God as the only hope to survive the evil practices in this world.
