Frank Benton Skinner, 87, lifelong resident of Indianapolis, passed away peacefully July 12, 2023. He was born June 5, 1936 to the late Lewis B. and Rosemary (Brown) Skinner. Frank was a graduate of Shortridge High School and attended Franklin College. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army, and married Mary Alice Reid, December 1, 1962 and she preceded him in death October 18, 2021 after 59 years of marriage.
