Gary G. Trinkle,

76, of Greenfield, passed away Wednesday, November 11, 2020. He was born in Valeene, IN, on September 20, 1944 to Glen and Margaret Lucille (Stroud) Trinkle. Gary spent the first eight years of his schooling in a one-room school house. He was a 1963 graduate of Paoli High School, and he received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Accounting from Indiana University in 1969. Gary proudly served in the U.S. Army as a First Lieutenant from 1969-1971. He received a Purple Heart and Bronze Star for his actions in the Vietnam War. He spent most of his career as an accountant for the federal government at Fort Benjamin Harrison Finance Center.

Public visitation will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, November 20, 2020, followed by a private family service at 2:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel, 9606 E. Washington St. Burial will be at 3:00 p.m. at Park Cemetery in Greenfield and is open to the public.
