George Elwood Battles,

76, passed away October 5, 2021. He was born March 11, 1945 in Mishawaka, IN, to the late George F. and Dorothy Battles. George was a graduate of Riley High School, South Bend and Indiana Mortuary College. He married Marilyn Ann Schmelter, and was a licensed embalmer before joining the Indianapolis Police Department in 1966, retiring in 1987. George joined the Warren Township Volunteer Fire Department in 1970, and was the Fire Chief from 1987 until 1995. After retiring from the WTFD, he joined the Marion County Sheriff's Department, Warrant Division. George was a longtime member of Holy Spirit Catholic Church and Nativity Catholic Church. He was an avid fisherman, and enjoyed camping and going on cruises with his wife.
