



## Gerald "Jerry" R. Jenn

Gerald "Jerry" R. Jenn, 84, of Fishers, passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 2, 2025 surrounded by his loving family. Born in Minneapolis, Minnesota, Jerry was the son of Louis J. and Martha F. Yriola Jenn. He attended Indiana University before proudly serving 6 years in the Air National Guard Reserve. Following his service, Jerry joined the family business, Jenn-Air Corporation, where he worked until 1982. Jerry then purchased Indianapolis Aviation where he also earned his pilot's license. He later founded the Westwind Arabians Horse Training Center combining his passion for horses with his entrepreneurial spirit. Music was always an important part of Jerry's life. Since 1996 he was one of the lead trumpet players for the New Horizons Band, Indianapolis. He also performed with the Indianapolis Municipal Band from 2002-2021. Jerry loved to sing, lending his voice to the Holy Spirit Parish at Geist Choir for over 20 years and the Del Webb Britton Falls Choir in his later years. Jerry's zest for life was matched only by his devotion to his wife Joyce, family and friends. He will be remembered by his contagious smile, fun loving spirit and the joy he brought to every gathering. Jerry lived a life full of music, adventure and laughter. He will be deeply missed by all who had the privilege to know him.
