Gloria Jane Hall, 94, of Indianapolis, passed away February 8, 2015. She was born in Cincinnati, OH, June 11, 1920, to the late Roy C. and Jane (Faul) Menzel. Gloria spent most of her life in southern California. She graduated from Alhambra High School and attended Pasadena City College. Gloria was a former member of the First Methodist Church in Ontario, California. After moving to Indiana, she joined Resurrection Lutheran Church in Indianapolis. When young, she worked as a cashier for El REY Theatre in Alhambra. Later, she worked as an accounts analyst at Bank of America, a bookkeeper at Miller's Outpost, and in accounting for the Ontario International Airport, remaining actively employed until she was 82. She was a volunteer/hostess at Ontario International Airport and at Community Hospital South, Greenwood, Indiana. She had a long commitment to supporting disadvantaged children and enjoyed family, gardening, dogs, friends, work and travel. Gloria's husband, Theodore Randolph Hall, preceded her in death. She is survived by her three daughters, Randolyn Wiessen, Jacqueline Broen and Gail Bennett; grandchildren, Justin and Sara Bennett; Scott Broen, Elizabeth (Broen) LaFond, and Lisa Broen; and Jordan, Robert and Andrew Wiessen; and 12 great-grandchildren, Natalie and Emme Bennett-Bond; Jack Samuel, Maximillian, Damian, Juliette and Maverick LaFond; Ethan and Liam Broen; Austin and Gavin Wiessen; and two more great-grandchildren on the way. She is also survived by her brother, Roy C. Menzel; her cousin, Marian Manders;

and many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews.
