Grant McBroom⁷⁵, of Fishers, a retired businessman, passed away August 15, 2008. He was born January 31, 1933 in Indianapolis to Walter R. and Evelyn Mills McBroom, who have preceded him in death. As a boy, he was active in Boy Scouts of America and achieved the Eagle Scout Award. Grant graduated from Thomas Carr Howe High School in the Class of 1951 and attended the Class of 1955 at Franklin College, where he was a member of the Phi Delta Theta Fraternity.
