Harold O. Drummond

75, a lifetime resident of Indianapolis, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, September 14, 2014. He was born March 10, 1939 to the late Carl and Beulah Sanders Drummond and was a 1957 graduate of Arsenal Technical High School. He married the love of his life, Barbara McIntyre, April 11, 1958. Harold worked 26 years for the Indianapolis Police Department, retiring as a sergeant in 1987. He then spent 20 years with the Marion County Sheriff's Department, retiring in 2007.

He served people in the Indianapolis community throughout his life, and loved sharing God's gift of music in area nursing homes and at Bible Study Chapel where he was a member and worshipped. Harold was also a long-time member of The Fraternal Order of Police #86 and Evergreen Oriental Masonic Lodge #500, F. & A.M., for 43 years.

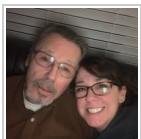

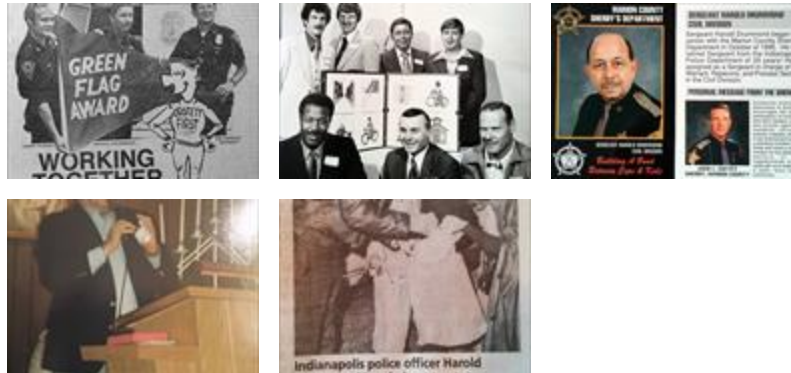
