Harry Eugene Russell,

92, of Fishers, passed away May 15, 2025. He was born January 3, 1933 in Indianapolis to the late Byron and Elizabeth (Hundley) Russell. Harry was a graduate of Cathedral High School and received his bachelor's degree from Marian College, where he lettered in baseball. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army's 3rd Infantry Division "Rock of the Marne" from 1953-1955. Harry married Jacqueline Codarmaz June 18, 1960 and was a cost accountant for Chrysler Corporation for over 26 years, and after retiring in 1989 he worked for the Indianapolis Racquet Club.

Harry was a longtime member of Holy Spirit at Geist Catholic Church where he was active in the choir, a reader, and an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. He was an avid athlete with a passion for tennis, pickleball and table tennis. He was a dedicated alumnus of Cathedral High School and penned the newsletter for the Cathedral High School Class of 1950.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Wednesday, May 21, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. at Holy Spirit at Geist Catholic Church, 10350 Glaser Way, with visitation from 9:00 a.m. until the time of mass.

Harry is survived by his loving wife of nearly 65 years, Jackie Russell; children, Michael Patrick Russell (Lisa), Cathleen Ann Leganza (John), Mary Pat Maier (Jeff), and Angela Marie White (Drew); seven grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by five brothers and three sisters.
