Helen G. ❖Hona❖ Stewart, 93, wife of the late James J. Stewart, attorney, released from this life on October 4, 2007. She was a lifelong resident of Indianapolis and an active member of Downey Avenue Christian Church. Helen was a graduate of Shortridge High School and Butler University, and a member of the Pi Beta Phi sorority, Tri Kappa, Latrian and the Daughters of the American Revolution. Helen served as President of the PTA for Indianapolis Public School No. 57, which her children attended. She was a Cub Scout den mother and a member of the Benton House Association and the Irvington Historical Landmarks Foundation. In the 1930s, she had worked as ❖Mary Baker❖ for a call-in radio show for Omar Baking Company. Helen was an avid fan and supporter of Butler University Athletics and faithfully attended their football and basketball games for over 60 years until poor health recently prevented her. She is survived by her sister, Marian Hostettler; her sons, Kent, Pete and James R. Stewart; 9 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren and countless friends.
