Herbert Walter Drinkut⁸⁶, of Indianapolis, passed away October 17, 2007. He was born December 7, 1920 in Indianapolis to Edward C. and Grace L. Rodman Drinkut. Herb served as a Corporal in the Army Air Corp during WWII stationed in England. He joined the Army the day after his 21st birthday, Pearl Harbor Day. He received a Bronze Battle Star and several medals while serving his country. He was a member of the 8th Air Force Historical Society and the 8th Air Force 3rd Strategic Air Depot Association. He was a member of the Plumbers & Steamfitters Unions 73 & 440 for an impressive 68 years. He owned a partnership in Arthur Paetz Plumbing for 50 years.
