Herbert Rollo was born September 24, 1938 in Chicago, IL to the late Herbert D. Rollo Sr. and Wilma Reger Rollo. He lived in Long Island, NY and Winchester, MA until the death of his father and then his mother moved his family to Indianapolis. Herb graduated from Tech High School, the School of Civil Engineering at Purdue University and Indiana University School of Law. While at Purdue, he was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon social fraternity. He married Nancy Cron in 1963, whom he had met at Zion Evangelical UCC. Herb worked for the Indiana State Highway department until moving to Huntington, IN where he practiced law for over 30 years in the firm of Rollo, Harter & Poling. In Huntington, he served as President of the Exchange Club and the American Red Cross. Herb served on the church board of St. Peter's UCC. For 13 retirement years, he and his wife wintered at Cypress Bend in Estero, FL.
