November 16, 1921 - February 9, 2013

Herbert Edwin Wrancher, 91, of Indianapolis, passed away February 9, 2013. He was born November 16, 1921, in Louisville, KY, to the late Charles Edwin and Evelyn Louise Helck Wrancher. Herbert was a graduate of Arsenal Tech High School, Class of 1939, Rose Polytechnic Institute in 1941 and Indiana University in 1948. He served his country in WWII in the U. S.
