Ives P. McClellan, 67, of Greenfield, IN, passed away November 6, 2016. Ives was born April 15, 1949 in Detroit, MI, to the late Ives and Elizabeth Carville McClellan. He married Barbara J. Langewisch, December 18, 1971. Ives graduated from the University of Detroit Jesuit High School in 1967, received his B.A. degree from John Carroll University of Cleveland OH, and earned his M.A. degree from Wayne State University in Detroit. He was a teacher for 37 years at St. Hugo of the Hills in Bloomfield Hills, MI, retiring in 2007. Ives was a member of Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Indianapolis.
