Jack Stuart Warner, Sr.

92, lifelong resident of Indianapolis, passed away October 28, 2024. He was born April 6, 1932 to the late Carl W. and Helen Louise Milligan. Jack was a 1950 graduate of Arsenal Technical High School who proudly served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War. He married Rosa Maria Rodriguez, and she preceded him in death August 26, 1996. Jack was employed with Crossroads Dairy Farm (an affiliate of Kroger Grocery) for 42 years.

Jack was a longtime parishioner of Little Flower Catholic Church. He was a member of the American Legion and enjoyed volunteering at the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.
