



James Raymond Shattuck

James Raymond Shattuck, 97, was born in Brazil, IN, in 1915, to the late James A. and Lucy (Butt) Shattuck. He graduated from Linton High School and served his country in the U.S. Army Air Corps from 1942 to 1946 as a crew chief on B-17 ✦s during WWII. After his discharge, James joined his father who had a fleet of trucks distributing Kingan Meat Products until 1966, and retired from A.W.D. in 1987. James was a 70 year member of the Mystic Tie Masonic Lodge, a 32nd Degree Mason of the Scottish Rite, from whom he received the Meritous Service Award, and the Murat Shrine. He was a longtime member and past president of both the Gatling Gun Club and the Murat Gun Club. James was a lifetime member of the Plainfield American Legion.
