James Albert White, 74, Indianapolis, passed away Tuesday, October 9, 2007. He was born June 25, 1933 in Indianapolis. James graduated from Arsenal Technical High School and attended Indiana University. He served in the U.S. Air Force and worked as a clerk in Archives for the State of Indiana. James was a tournament-rated chess player from 1970-1990 and coached a ♦Peace Games♦ chess team that won against Canada in the 1980s.
