



## Jason McKissock

May 15, 1973 - September 17, 2021

Jason McKissock, beloved father and husband age 48, of Indianapolis, passed away on Friday, September 17th after a long battle with brain cancer. Jason was born in Richmond Hill Ontario to Steve and Jose McKissock. He grew up in Carrying Place Ontario with Lake Ontario as his backyard. He was a gifted athlete enjoying hockey, rugby, volleyball, and track and field. He earned a scholarship to Indiana University to run the 400-meter hurdles and also threw the javelin. He represented Canada at the World University Games in Japan earning a silver medal in the 400-meter hurdles. He finished his career running in the Canadian Olympic Trials in 1996. He remained competitive playing hockey in a local league until his cancer diagnosis. He had a long career working in construction management. He is survived by his wife Blair McKissock and three daughters: Kendall, Josie, and Maggie. A celebration of life will be held from 2 pm to 6 pm on October 2nd.
