“ Jeanette was one of my dearest St. Philip friends. As piano students of Sr. Agnes Dolores, Jeanette and I were assigned to "play the march" each day at the noon and at the 3 pm dismissals. We sat on the piano bench on the middle landing where the large stained glass window looked out onto Eastern Avenue. The statue of the Blessed Virgin was in the middle, and the piano at one side, and the drum at the other side. Sometimes, Larry Bowman would join us as the drummer. When Sister Viola Marie or Sister Joseph Marie (the Principals during a several year period of time) rang the bell, Jeanette and I would launch into one of any number of Sousa marches while the 800 or so SPN students marched out for lunch or for afternoon dismissal. We shared more than a laugh or two, as well as an abiding friendship, many overnights at each other's homes, and a road trip or two to family farms and other destinations. I considered the Maders a second family. Jeanette and I were "left in charge" the night Mrs. Mader delivered her first son. Those girls were really excited to have a couple of boys eventually come their way. Many years later, I was pleased to meet Jeanette's son and grandchildren when I worked at Scecina. Those connections just kept coming. To all of Jeanette's family, sisters, brothers, sons, daughter, grandchildren and great-grandchildren - - - she was one of a kind and will always be with you in your hearts and memories, as she will be with many of us who knew her when she was a child playing happily on Eastern Avenue. Rest well, my friend. You have earned the reward you were always promised.
