Jerome "Jerry" Francis Lukowitz, 85, of Greenwood, Indiana, passed away peacefully February 24, 2025, surrounded by family. He was born April 14, 1939 in Chicago, Illinois to Frank J. and Frances (Pijanowski) Lukowitz. Jerry was a 1957 graduate of Fenwick High School in Oak Park, Illinois.
