Joel graduated from Butler University in 1963 and was a member of Phi Delta Theta Fraternity. He taught at Westfield High School from 1963-1970 and spent the last forty years at Pike High School where he served as a guidance counselor, English teacher and coach of the cross country and track teams before retiring in 2010. He was the swim team coach and pool manager at Hillcrest Country Club from 1968-2009 and a coach for Allisonville Youth Baseball.
