John Grigsby Foyer,

87, of Indianapolis, went home to his Savior, Christ Jesus, on October 4, 2014. He was born in Chicago, Illinois, January 31, 1927, to the late Harold S. and Elizabeth (Grigsby) Foyer. Graduating from Morgan Park High School in 1945, he served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

After a brief football career was ended by injury, John graduated in 1950 from the University of Wisconsin as a member of Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity.

John spent his entire business career in the insurance field, settling in Indianapolis, where he married Ann (Gough) in 1955. After working for American United Life Insurance Company for 19 years, he formed his own insurance agency in 1975, moving to Carmel shortly thereafter.

John was a Carmel Rotarian and a member of Woodland Country Club, where he enjoyed playing golf. Affectionately called "Big Plug," he was always there for his family and was well known for attending the sporting events of his four children as their biggest fan.

John is survived by his wife of 59 years, Ann; children, Gregory Foyer, Miriam Oren (Doug), Kyle Foyer and Martha Faulconer (JB); 12 grandchildren; and ten great-grandchildren. His sister, Jean Jones, preceded him in death.
