John Thomas Lamson Sr., 80, of Rushville, Indiana, passed away March 12, 2025. He was born May 16, 1944 in Chicago, IL to the late Robert D Lamson, Sr and Rhe deLyte Lamson. John graduated from Lawrence Central High School and attended Indiana State and Purdue University. John was a Seabee with the United States Navy. He then joined the Architecture firm of Wright Porteous & Lowe.
