John J. Runciman, Jr., 87, of Fishers, passed away May 22, 2009. He was born June 20, 1921 in Dundee, Scotland to John J. Sr., and Margaret Ferguson Runciman. John was a 1939 graduate of Tech High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII in the Pacific Theater as Military Police and photographer.
