John Michael "Mike" Smith, 81, of Fishers, passed away September 19, 2025. He was born May 31, 1944 in Cambridge, Ohio, to the late John Raymond and Othella Maxine (Proctor) Smith. Mike graduated from Hoover High School in North Canton, Ohio, received his bachelor's degree from Adrian College, and received two master's degrees from Indiana Wesleyan University. He proudly served his country in the U.S. Army from 1962-1965 and later as First Lt. in the National Guard where he attained his Jump Wings. Mike was employed at GTE/Verizon as a Network Planning Specialist for 40 years, retiring in 2012.
