Jonathan Lee Horne, 33, accomplished artist, musician, and mixologist, passed away on January 2, 2021 after a brief but fierce battle with cancer. Born January 20, 1987, Jonathan thrived on his work both in and among the music and hospitality communities of Indianapolis, Bloomington and New York City.

Jonathan was a longtime employee of independent record label Joyful Noise Recordings. It was at Joyful Noise where Jonathan worked alongside some of his favorite bands, developed relationships with hundreds of fellow music fans, and created hand-made lathe-cut 7 inch records.

Jonathan is survived by his mother, Kathryn (Andy) Baumgartner; father, James Horne; sister, Hannah Baumgartner; and maternal grandparents, Larry and Ann Ambs. And of course, his beloved ferret "Potato". He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, John "Jack" Horne, Jr. and Christina "Betty" Horne.
