Binkley ♦s was the social hub of the north side. Joe ♦s favorite customers included, David Letterman, Eli Lilly, Jr., Tuffy Mitchell, Mitch Daniels, Mayor John Barton and Marilyn Quayle. He enjoyed playing euchre, bridge, and also enjoyed fishing and golfing. Joe was a member of the Notre Dame and Butler Alumni Associations, and was a former member of the St. Andrew Catholic Church of Indianapolis and San Marco Church in Marco Island, FL.
