90, of Indianapolis, passed away June 18, 2017. He was born November 7, 1926 in Indianapolis to the late Joseph Tyler Wilson, Jr. and Fay Wilson. He graduated from Thomas Carr Howe High School. Joseph served his country in the U. S. Navy from 1943 through 1946 serving in the Pacific Fleet during WW II and then in the U. S. Air Force from 1951 until 1953.

Joseph started work in 1953 at the Ft. Harrison Officers Club and attended the PGA School at the Collanades Hotel in 1964. He then served as manager of Supreme Golf Facility for three years and ten years as Head Professional and Greens Superintendent at Wabash Country Club, Mississinewa Country Club and the Carroll Country Club. Joseph finished his career at Crooked Stick Golf Course in Carmel and was involved in the 1991 PGA Tournament and also the 1993 USGA Women's Open, as well as the annual Pete Dye National Pro-AM.
