She received her bachelor's degree and masters degree from Indiana University in elementary education where she was a member of Sigma Kappa Sorority and Pi Lambda Theta Philanthropic Sorority.

Julie was an elementary school teacher for Center Grove School System from 1984-1999, retiring in 1999. Later in life, she was a Teacher Assistant in the Bartholomew School Corporation, teaching both in the Special Education Department and ESL Summer Program.

Julie enjoyed traveling in the United States and abroad, visiting the Grand Canyon in Arizona, Los Angeles, Toronto, England France, Italy, and Switzerland. 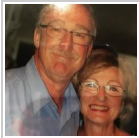
