June B. Johnson, 92, of Fishers, passed away December 22, 2014. June was born June Barbara Mathews and was raised in Jasonville, IN, where she attended Jasonville High School and then graduated from the Indiana Business College in Indianapolis. She moved to Indianapolis to start her secretarial career. Shortly thereafter, she met Francis Johnson, and they were married in June of 1943. June began her professional career at Fort Benjamin Harrison where she retired in 1985, with over 30 years of service.
