Kathleen G. Hoge, 98, was peacefully received into the arms of her Lord and Savior on March 15, 2024, in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Kathy was born on February 11, 1926 in St. Louis, Missouri, to Alva and Carmen (Snaveley) Broadfoot. She was baptized on October 17, 1926 at Lafayette Methodist Church in St. Louis. In 1940, she confirmed her faith at Christ Lutheran Church in Webster Groves, Missouri. Kathy was unwavering in her faith and those who knew her understood she was the epitome of Proverbs 31:29.
