Kay Diane Cremeans Johnston-Fitzpatrick, 77, of Fishers, passed away July 1, 2024. She was born September 25, 1946 in Columbus, Ohio to the late Elza and Ruth Jane (Bare) Cremeans.

Family, faith and friends were the most important parts of Kay's life. She was known for her dedication, problem solving, kindness and tireless hard work on behalf of her clients, who often became friends.
