June 12, 1924 - November 9, 2016

Kenneth A. Apple, 92, of Indianapolis passed away November 9, 2016. He was born June 12, 1924 to the late Arthur K. and Dorothy Stuard Apple. Born and raised on the east side of Indianapolis, Kenneth graduated from Arsenal Technical High School, class of 1942. He served with honors in the U.S. Army Air Force, WWII, from 1943-1945, spending seven months overseas, serving with the 15th Air Force based in Lecce, Italy and, as a member of the 98th Bomb Group, flew 35 missions and was shot down twice. He married his high school sweetheart, Anna E. Ratcliffe who preceded him in death after 56 years of marriage. He then married Jeanne Lorentz who also preceded him in death. He was employed at J.D. Adams Co. for 24 years and then at Allison Transmission for 18 years, retiring in 1984. He was a longtime member of East 38th Street/Post Road Christian Church, East 91st Street Christian Church, and, most recently, Speedway Christian Church.

Kenneth is survived by his children; Stephen A. Apple (Joni), and Janice A. Apple Montgomery (Jim); grandchildren, Angela Apple Rihani (John), Laura Ridderman (Nate), Jason Montgomery (Lisa), and Jennifer Montgomery Mayhill (Cameron); and eight great-granddaughters.
