Kenneth A. Kohlhoff, 68, of Indianapolis, IN, passed from this life into eternal life on Thursday, December 17, 2020 at St. Vincent Ascension Hospital. Kenneth, known by his loved ones as Ken or Kenny, was born July 27, 1952 to John Balthasar Kohlhoff and Daphne Ann Kohlhoff (née Clancy) in Chennai, India.
