Larry Deane Sipe, 84, of Indianapolis, passed away February 19, 2025. He was born September 12, 1940 in Lebanon, Indiana to the late Harold and Ruth (Cochran) Sipe. Larry was a 1958 graduate of Lebanon High School and received his bachelor's degree in business from Indiana Central College now known as the University of Indianapolis.
