



## Lester V. Reynolds

August 6, 1922 - February 6, 2008

Lester (Les) Virgil Reynolds, 85, passed away Wednesday, February 6, 2008 in Indianapolis, IN. He was born August 6, 1922 in Molus, KY to James Soloman and Delia Ellen (Blanton) Reynolds, Jr. He was baptized as a member of the Flat Lick Baptist Church, Somerset, KY in 1935. From 1952 to 1959 he and brother Herman Reynolds owned and operated Reynolds Garage on So. Alabama, an automotive business that also maintained the Indianapolis Police Department Motor Fleet. When the establishment was destroyed by fire, Les relocated the business to the far eastside of Indianapolis. He was a charter member of the Indiana Automotive Maintenance Association, was employed by Fruehauf Trailers for 20 years and Commercial Motor Freight, retiring in 1981. A 20-year accident free driving record earned him the privilege of making a commercial for Valvoline Oil.
