Linda L. Cripe, MD, 77, of Fishers, IN, passed away March 3, 2024. She was born March 7, 1946, in Chicago, IL, to the late Donald L. Mosher, Sr. and Kathleen (Eagan) Mosher. Linda received a bachelor's degree from Earlham Collage in 1968 and went on to graduate from IU School of Medicine. She began her 40-year medical career as an MD specializing in Pediatrics.
