Lola Z. Stanley, Age 66, died peacefully December 18, 2008, at home surrounded by her family. She fought a brave battle against cancer for over 6 years. The organization's charitable mission benefits children with Juvenile Arthritis. But, Lola's ultimate mission in life was caring for and loving her husband, her daughters and her grandchildren.
