Magda Mary Lewis, 81, died December 13, 2008 after a long battle with cancer. Born Magdolna Mary Takacs in Munkacs, Hungary to János and Julianna, she fled home at the age of 16 with her family during WWII. While living in a refugee camp in Germany, she met and married US Army Counter Intelligence Corps officer Alexander C. St. Paul. They and their children, Christine and Mark, traveled extensively during his army career, and were privileged to experience life in many countries. Magda and her family moved to North Vernon upon Al's retirement from the army. She and Al worked at Muscatatuck State Hospital, where she started her career in medical records. After Al's death, Magda married George Chauncey Lewis and moved to Madison, where they enjoyed life together for 18 years. She relocated to Fishers upon Chauncey's death, and has been an employee of Northside Internal Medicine since 1998. Magda was a volunteer at St. Vincent Hospital and a member of the Retired Officers Club. She was known among her friends and colleagues for her warmth and generosity, and her wonderful Hungarian cooking. Magda is preceded in death by her brother János, and husbands Alexander C. St. Paul and George Chauncey Lewis. She is survived by her sister Terez Lenart, children Christine and Mark St. Paul, grandchildren Jennifer and Joseph Dubeansky, great grandchildren Joseph and Daniel Dubeansky, and beloved nieces and nephews.
