Margaret M. Aull, 99, of Indianapolis, passed away January 10, 2023. She was born May 3, 1923, in Lafayette, IN, to the late William S. and Mary C. (Honer) Meehan. 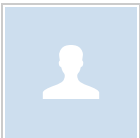
