



## Marjorie M. Clock

December 19, 1921 - November 25, 2010

Marjorie M. Clock, 88, of Indianapolis, passed away November 25, 2010 with her family at her side. She was born December 19, 1921 in Grant County, IN, to the late Orville and Ruth (Underwood) Hasty. Marjorie graduated from high school in Jefferson Township, IN. She married Rev. Willis Clock on October 26, 1940 and he preceded her in death on December 6, 1995. Marjorie served 40 years with her husband in the ministry. They pastored Pilgrim Holiness Churches in Terre Haute, Evansville, and English, IN. They also served as district superintendent of the Western Pennsylvania district of the Pilgrim Holiness Church. They then pastored Wesleyan Churches in Maude, OH, and Mitchell, IN. They retired to Tavares and Leesburg, FL. where they were instrumental in starting new Nazarene Churches. For the past 15 years, Marjorie lived in Indianapolis and was involved in the senior ministries of the Indianapolis First Church of the Nazarene where she was a member.
