



Marjorie E. "Marge" Lowe Lawhorn

April 17, 1928 - July 15, 2015

Marjorie E. "Marge" Lawhorn, 87, of New Palestine, passed away suddenly in the early hours of July 15, 2015. She was born April 17, 1928, in Indianapolis to the late Hoyet and M. Ellen Sullivan Lowe. Marge graduated from Arsenal Technical High School and went to Butler University for the first time, graduating Cum Laude with a BS in Accounting. While at Butler, she was a member of Trianon Sorority, serving a term as its president. Many of her sorority sisters were her closest lifelong friends. After graduation, she married the sweetheart of her youth, Robert Lawhorn. Marge later returned to Butler, obtaining a Master in Education in 1974. She was a teacher at IPS for over 22 years and known for her crafts that still decorate many people's homes. After retiring, she volunteered for Hancock County Senior Services and Lutheran Disabilities. Bob preceded her in death on February 16, 1998, faithfully caring for him during a protracted illness.

Visitation will be Friday, July 17, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel, 9606 E. Washington St. with funeral services Saturday at 2:00 p.m.

Marge is survived by her children, Linda Soper and Larry Lawhorn; five grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren.

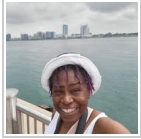
