Mark Alan Bullington, 59, of Fishers, passed away May 15, 2024. He was born April 15, 1965 in Indianapolis to the late Daniel Paul and Irma Lee (Stephenson) Bullington. Mark was a 1983 graduate of Warren Central High School where he played both basketball and golf. He was subsequently inducted into the 1996 Indiana High School Golf Hall of Fame. He attended Indiana University and Ball State University, playing golf for both institutions. He received his Master's degree from Butler University. Mark and Amy L. Hancz met on a blind date in the fall of 1995 and married in 1997. He was employed by Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield for more than 30 years, retiring in 2020 as Director of Sales. Mark was fortunate to spend 4 years of retirement playing as much golf as he could. He was devoted to the game and loved nothing more than playing with family and friends. He also loved any opportunity to extend a helping hand to anyone that wanted to learn the game or just improve their skills. It was not uncommon to look over during a gathering of friends and see him helping someone with their swing. The golf channel was a permanent fixture on the television, 24/7. He and Alex spent many years playing at Prairie View Golf Club, and it always held a special place in his heart. He also loved boating, especially tying up with friends on a sunny afternoon, floating in a cove and listening to music. He loved waterskiing, snow skiing, and riding motorcycles with Alex and friends. Mark shared his love of sports with Alex, teaching him how to golf at an early age, and took pride in coaching him in T-ball,

basketball and football. He especially loved to cheer for the Colts, Pacers and Indiana University with the Colts Garage Group. Mark loved listening to sports podcasts, especially Pat McAfee, listening to music, talking cars and motorsports, especially NHRA.
