



## Mary Marcia Fleming

June 22, 1943 - January 12, 2021

Mary Marcia (Moran) Fleming, 77, previously of Charlottesville, VA, passed away January 12, 2021 in Fishers, Indiana. Marcia, as she was known to friends and family, was born in Andover, New York on June 22, 1943.
