Mary Jane Meyer,

84, of Carmel, passed away September 2, 2022. She was born July 15, 1938 in Cleveland, Ohio to the late Alexander L. and Ruth E. Morrison Kraft. Jane was a graduate of Rocky River High School, Class of 1956 in Cleveland, Ohio and received her bachelor's degree from Ohio State University, Class of 1960, where she was the Majorette for the marching band, and a member of Alpha Phi Sorority. Jane received her Master's Degree from Butler University. She married Ronald Lee Meyer August 28, 1960 and they have been married for 62 years. Jane began her 28-year teaching career in 1961 with Chillicothe City Schools, taking a hiatus to raise their two daughters from 1967-1980. Jane was active in both daughters' schools as a room mother and member of the PTO. She began teaching again with the Indianapolis Public School System, Washington Township Schools and the Noblesville School System. Jane was an active member of the Indiana State Teacher Association. Jane hosted her own Art TV Show called "Adventures and Art with Jane" in Ohio during the 1960's. She volunteered her time at Thorpe Creek Elementary School with her daughter, Wendy, sharing her love of art with the students. Jane was a member and past president of the Woodland Green Gardening Club for over 20 years. She was an active member of Orchard Park Presbyterian Church and the Women's Bible Study, and she also enjoyed playing bridge with friends. Out of all the things she has done, she enjoyed spending time with her children and grandchildren, who were the love of her

life, along with her many family pets. Jane enjoyed traveling, gardening, art creation, spreading God's word and social interactions with her many friends on Facebook.

Jane believed in being a donor, and in the end she was able to give the life saving and healing gift of skin grafts. Breast cancer survivors are able to use her skins for reconstructive surgeries.

A memorial visitation will be held Saturday, September 17, 2022 from 2:00 p.m. until the time of service at 4:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Fishers-Castleton Chapel, 9900 Allisonville Road.

Jane is survived by her loving husband, Ronald L. Meyer; daughters, Laura Williams (Donnie) and Wendy Meyer (special friend, Steve Rice); grandchildren, Evan Wells (Meghan), Parker Wells and Lindsay Jane Wells; one brother and one sister; and her cat, Junior/Kitty.
