



## Mary Mildred Trueblood Marsh

February 15, 1922 - December 19, 2008

Mildred Trueblood Marsh, 86, of Indianapolis, died December 19, 2008. Born February 15, 1922, in Indianapolis, she was the daughter of Clifford Emmett and Natio Douglass Trueblood. She graduated from Warren Central High School in 1940 and later that year married Max Martin Marsh. They divorced in the 1970s. An Eastside homemaker, an active Quaker and gifted musician, Mildred was a member of First and Irvington Friends Churches in Indianapolis and for much of the 1940s and 1950s she served as their Organist and Choir Director. At age 50 Mildred entered the workforce as a professional musician, performing as a freelance pianist, working and living for the next 30 years in Greenfield, Nashville, and Indianapolis. Mildred is survived by her children, Timothy J. Marsh of Camby, Deborah Lynn (Gary) Kinkead of Indianapolis, Shawn D. (James Struthers) Marsh of Chicago, and Neil P. (Beckie Hunter) Marsh of Boston, and grandchildren, M. Tanner Kinkead, Timothy C. Marsh and Tyler R. Marsh.
