Marylynn departed this world in the early morning hours of June 15, 2025 after a brief but determined battle with cancer. Born to musician parents (the late Lynn and Mary Esther Williamson) on July 18, 1946, Marylynn spent her Indianapolis childhood immersed in the arts. She inherited a boundless creative energy that she applied first to a career in advertising and public relations and then to numerous entrepreneurial ventures. A lifelong learner, she returned to school and earned her bachelor's degree from Indiana Wesleyan University in 1997. She also became a writer, editor, and researcher for Pearson Education. Later in life, Marylynn devoted her time and energy to her ministry, the Bible and Prayer Power Hour, with a desire to help individuals who, like her son, Greg, have suffered traumatic brain injuries.

One of Marylynn's most profound joys was supporting the artistic endeavors of her granddaughters, relishing every moment of their piano and violin recitals, Indianapolis Children's Choir shows, and performances at the Mud Creek Playhouse, Riverside Junior High, and Fishers High School. She also loved spending time with Greg, watching British mystery shows and going to so many movies.

Marylynn is survived by her daughter, Jenny Fitzpatrick Perry, and son-in-law, Rob Perry; son, Greg Fitzpatrick; stepson, Michael Stults, Jr.; and granddaughters, Grace and Margaret Perry. She was preceded in death by

her husband, Michael Stults; and brother, J.N. Williamson. The family would like to thank all Marylynn's caregivers and friends who have supported us during this time, with special thanks to Chris Prange, Ginger Fitzpatrick, and Dawn Johnston.
