



## Maurice "Moe" Himes

March 3, 1942 - July 3, 2024

Maurice "Moe" Himes, 82, of Fishers, passed away peacefully July 3, 2024 at his residence surrounded by family members. Although saddened by their loss his family rejoices in his graduation to the presence of his Savior Yeshua Hamashiach (Jesus the Messiah). Moe was born March 3, 1942 to Samuel and Anna Himes. He grew up in Indianapolis, raised in the Jewish tradition alongside his siblings. Moe attended Shortridge High School and worked in his father's grocery store as a young man. He met the love of his life Myrlene through mutual friends in 1961. Moe and Myrlene were married in 1962 beginning a 62-year journey of love and family. Moe became a successful entrepreneur, owning and operating several automotive businesses in central Indiana where he built life-long relationships over the years. He will be remembered as a kind and generous businessman that put his customers first. Moe was a devoted husband and father, who took great joy in participating in his children's lives, including events like little league baseball, track meets, car shows, drag racing, and family trips. Moe was a strong Christian, recognizing Jesus as the anticipated Messiah spoken about in the Old Testament scriptures (Isaiah 53:1-12). He reflected the life of Christ in how he lived, speaking of Him regularly to family and friends.

Moe is preceded in death by his parents, Samuel and Anna Himes; stepmother, Sydell Himes; siblings, Thomas Himes, Sally (Himes) Sacks, and Betty (Himes) Shorr; son, David Himes; and granddaughter, Esther Himes.
