Max E. Hunter,

61, of Trafalgar, passed away surrounded by his loved ones December 11, 2022 after a yearlong battle with pancreatic cancer. 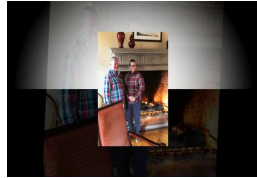
