



## Max L. Moser

July 5, 1943 - March 21, 2016

Max L. Moser,

Indianapolis passed away Monday afternoon, March 21, 2016. Born July 5, 1943, in Decatur, Indiana, to 2nd Lieutenant Robert M. Moser and Delores Worden Moser. His father perished during a military training exercise in 1944. In 1947 his mother married Richard C. Gerber Sr., who raised Max as one of his own.

A 1961 graduate of Adams Central High School, Max earned his Bachelors and Masters degrees at Ball State University. While at Ball State Max was a member of Phi Sigma Epsilon, served as president of the Young Republicans and was treasurer of the Midwest Federation of College Republicans.

Max's post-college life began as a teacher at Eaton High school, then he moved to Muncie Central. In 1969 Max became the Assistant Director, Research and International Trade Divisions, Indiana Department of Commerce. Other positions included Administrative Assistant, to the Executive Vice-president Dolly Madison Industries; Director of Research & Special Projects, Indiana State Chamber of Commerce; Executive Director of Indiana and Indianapolis Bowling Proprietors' Associations; and from 1988 until 2004 he served the Indianapolis City-County Council as Research Director. From 2004 until his retirement in 2008 Max was a counselor for Marion County Community Corrections – ending his career as it began - working with young people. Community involvement was important to Max and through the years he was active in the Indianapolis Jaycees, the Indiana

and Indianapolis Economic Forums, the Indiana Advisory Council of the U. S. Small Business Administration, Far Eastside Neighborhood Association and the Warren Township Development Association. For several years he also served as a corporal in the Indiana Guard Reserve.

Republican to his core, Max served as precinct committeeman, ward chairman, president of the Warren Township Republican Club, and assisted on many, many campaigns. From 1970 to 2000 he was elected to the Warren Township Advisory Board.

Max was an active member of St. John United Church of Christ and the Columbia Club. He was a Sagamore of the Wabash, a Kentucky Colonel, and an Honorary Citizen of New Orleans. He was currently serving as secretary of the Indianapolis East Rotary Club and as treasurer of the Indianapolis Postcard Club.

Max is survived by his wife of over 47 years, Barbara J. Baldwin Moser; sons, Max L. (Fritz) Moser II (Melissa) and Robert P. Moser; grandson Max L. Moser III; brother, Richard C. Gerber, Jr., Decatur, Indiana; sisters, Linda Harman (Mrs. Dick), Decatur, Indiana, and Gloria Miller (Mrs. Bill) Bluffton, Indiana, along with several nieces, nephews and grand-nieces and grand-nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and his son Joshua A. Moser.

Visitation will be Friday, March 25, 2016 from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. at Shirley Brothers Washington Memorial Chapel, 9606 E. Washington St. and Saturday from 12 noon until the time of service at 1:00 p.m.
